


Dazzling in their differences


We found a hidden gem: more than just a hotel but a true paradise on earth. Tucked away between Pisa and Cinque Terre, the Augustus Hotel and Resort is certainly one for the books. Since 2024, three new villas have been included in the Augustus Hotel and Resort repertoire: Villa Ala Anita, Villa Ala Bianca and Villa Radici. While each building provides different outlooks, viewpoints and scenery, they all have a common point: elegance and sophistication at its finest.

The Maschietto family, including brothers Fiammetta, Federico and Vittorio, hold on to tradition by continuing to preserve the hotel's beauty, sophistication and alluring ambiance. Walking into Augustus, guests are met with smiling faces ready to lure visitors into a lavish Mediterranean escape with breathtaking views and immaculate grounds. While the Augustus is made up of several separate buildings and villas, the main houses, Villa Pesenti and La Nave, offer stunning escapes. Each room is beautifully designed with spacious bathrooms, comfortable beds, air-conditioning systems and memorable views as far as the eye can see. The hotel offers guests an on-site gym, pools, spa, bicycles, boats as well as delectable dining destinations, including La Sirena e La Fontana and Bambaissa.
